

## New access plan to the Study Kim LAGAE

The City of Brussels will implement traffic measures at the Pentagon starting 16/8, as part of the Good Move Pentagon plan.

For access to the study located at the rue Royale n°55,

- An entrance from the inner circle to the rue Royale will be maintained DESPITE THE TRAFFIC SIGNS INDICATING THAT THE STREET IS A DEAD END :

- Either from the Boulevard Botanique
- Or via the Leuvensestraat (new access)
- Either via the Place des Barricades
- Or via the Surllet de Chokierplein (attention: afterwards, follow the Ijzerenkruisstraat because the Congresstraat will be closed off at the Vrijheidsplein)
- Or via Pachecolaan
- Either via Wetstraat and then via Hertogstraat (attention: unauthorised access via a filter system (via camera) is planned in the section between Wetstraat and Leuvensestraat)

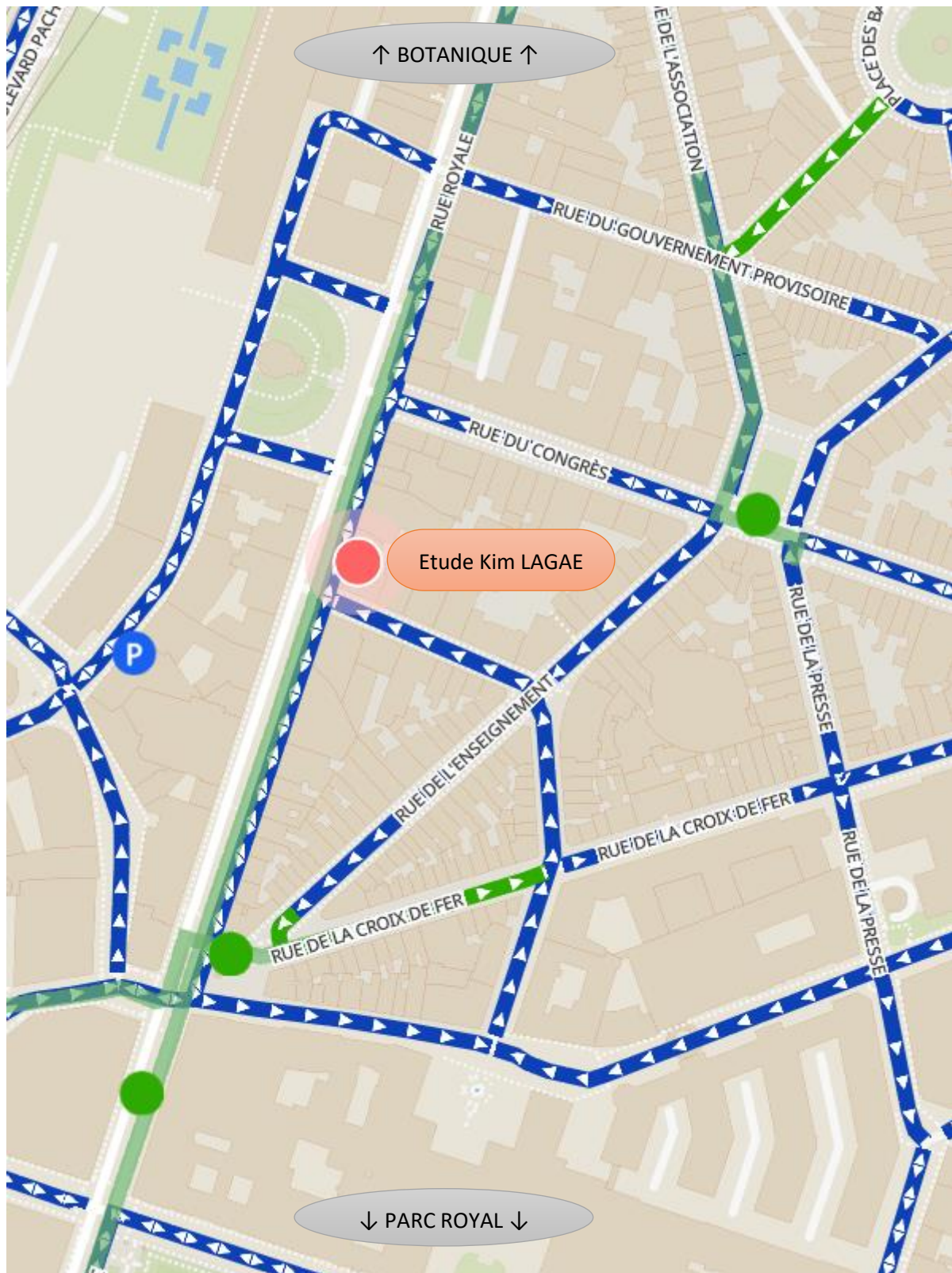
- the return trip from Koningsstraat to the inner ring road will be as follows:

- Either via Pachecolaan
- Or via the Boulevard Botanique
- Or via the Barricadeplein
